77.03 Minimum Safety Standards

77.01 DEFINITION. The term “moped” includes any motor vehicle designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground, with an engine having a displacement no greater than 50 cubic centimeters, or not capable of operation at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour on level ground, unassisted by human power.

77.02 OPERATION OF MOPEDS RESTRICTED. No person under the age of 16 shall operate or ride a moped upon any street within the City, unless the person is properly wearing a safety helmet and eye protective equipment that comply with the standards set out in Section 77.03 of this chapter.

77.03 MINIMUM SAFETY STANDARDS. The Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 218, *Motorcycle Helmets* (49DFR 571.218) and the American National Standards Institute Standard Z90.1 are established as the minimum performance requirements for safety helmets and eye protective equipment for moped operators and riders. The above standards shall be available for public inspection, and copying at the office of the City Clerk.
